Competition open to all dancers who are stepping onto the competition stage for the first time. Minimum of one step, but may compete up to two. These dancers may also enter the beginner competition.

A Beginner is a competitor who has not taken Irish dancing lessons from a registered teacher prior to Sept 1st of the previous year. Dancer must move into Advanced Beginner the following year.

No solo costumes allowed. Skirt/blouse or school costume only.
